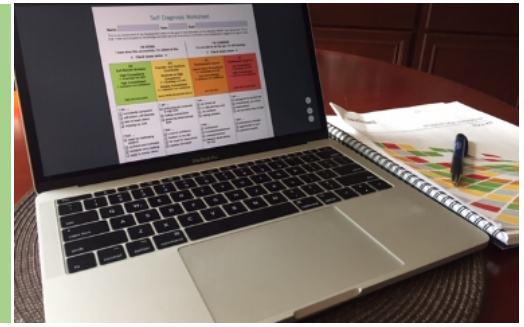


Virtual Student Self Leadership Camp!
